



LES JARDINS DE LA TOUR BLANCHE

Château La Tour Blanche is a First Growth of Sauternes classified in 1855. Besides its production of sweet white wines, this prestigious estate also produces Bordeaux wines including this red wine called Les Jardins de La Tour Blanche. The nose reveals subtle aromas of red fruits, toasted bread and roasted almonds. The palate seduces with notes of ripe red fruits, a touch of vanilla and a spicy finish. The aromatic persistency is remarkable.

Gravels over clay and limestone

100% hand-picked

Merlot

In stainless steel tanks with alternatives
Bottled at the château
